Hours: M - Th 7:45 – 11:45; 12:45 – 4:45 pm. Closed May – August.

Fees: Services range from \$15 - \$25. Dental insurance is not required or billed. Visit website for complete fee information.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: Provides preventive dental services for adults and children. Does not provide restorative dental procedures such as fillings or root canals. Walk-ins will be taken on an "availability only" basis. Scheduled appointments are preferred.

Hours: M - F 7 am – 6 pm (closed 12 noon - 1 pm)

Fees: Accepts most Medicaid programs, Medicare, PCN (except North Temple), CHIP, and most private insurance. Uses a sliding fee scale for uninsured patients based on household size and income.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: Vulnerable and underserved individuals in Salt Lake County regardless of their ability to pay.

Hours: M - F 9 am - 4 pm; Call ahead or visit website as dentist's availability may vary.

Fees: Set, based on procedure. Typically, 70% below commercial costs. Payment requirements discussed at initial appointment.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: Anyone that is low-income, underinsured, or uninsured. Must meet income requirements

Fees: Initial screening & consultation to determine eligibility is free. Once accepted as patient, please call for detailed prices. Accepts Medicaid and CHIP, and provide documentation for reimbursement for private insurance. Payment plans available.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: Urgent Care Clinic: children aged 4 and older (some exceptions apply), and adults.

Fees: No fees for the donated program. Set, discounted rate for the discounted dental program.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: Below 100% of the Federal Poverty Line for donated services, 200% for discounted services.

Fees: Sliding scale fee based on income, accepts most major insurance.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: Patients who earn less than 200% of the federal poverty line.

Fees: Vary; sliding-scale fee based on income. Most insurances accepted.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: Established clients or the general public in emergency situations.

Fees: Most insurance accepted. Student dentist heavily discounted off current market rate for self-pay only.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: The uninsured or who are paying out-of-pocket can get dental care at a discounted fee from dental students and residents who are supervised by licensed dentists.

Dental Insurance Programs

CHIP (Children's Health Insurance Program)

Provides comprehensive health insurance, including limited dental, to Utah children who qualify.

Information about enrolling: 877-KIDS-NOW (877-543-7669)

Hours: M - F 8 am - 5 pm

Fees: Vary by plan selected, no cost for information or signing up.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: U.S. citizen or legal resident, under age 19, at or below 200% of federal poverty income guidelines, and not covered by any other health insurance.

Medicaid- Utah Department of Health

Provides health coverage for Utah adults and children who qualify. Covered services vary according to type of Medicaid.

Enrollment: 801-538-6155

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: Eligibility is determined by the Department of Workforce Services (DWS) and varies according to type of Medicaid. Factors such as age, income and assets, medical condition, etc. can affect eligibility.
